Here is the February 2019 UKRAINE MISSIONS Newsletter for you to read! Included in this month's edition are a number of encouraging items. THANK YOU to all involved in the actions recorded in this report and in the many actions not recorded. More amazing actions are developing and I hope to be able to publicize these within the coming months. The ramifications of these for the Lord's Church globally are amazing!

In this newsletter I want to highlight a shipment we made into Moldova. Thus far this year we have shipped three containers into Moldova (loaded out of Midvale, UT; Columbus, MS; Judsonia, AR). The container shipped from Columbus, MS was sent to an orphanage and Kathy Cadden stuffed it with quality commodities. I am copying the report that was originally posted by Charita Shteynberg on the *World of Connections* web site (https://worldofconnections.org/news-blog/f/moldova-projects). Also arriving during February were containers shipped into the Republic of Georgia and Tanzania. Probably by the time you read this newsletter we will have loaded a container for Liberia out of Judsonia, AR and Tanzania out of Waukee, IA.

Jerry Max Morgan has been in Ukraine following up on the beginnings of our efforts to provide orphanages with a vocational training program. You have helped feed, clothe, provide for hygiene needs, provide school materials and a number of other items. But someone asked, "What happens AFTER leaving the orphanage?" Thanks to Jerry this query has begun to be answered and the Lord's Church will have a wonderful opportunity! MORE to come on this!

# DISTRIBUTION OF GOD'S LOVE ... MOLDOVA!

Since June of 2018, when the first opportunity to ship humanitarian aid to Moldova arose, we had a pleasure of sending four full loads to Moldova. Kind people in Wisconsin, Utah, Arkansas and now Mississippi worked hard, collected donations and packed full containers. Recently in response to a request for assistance to help the orphans in Moldova, Kathy Cadden (Columbus MS) responded with an eagerness to send a container. We were given a description of the current situation in Moldovan orphanages so we could pack suitable commodities. Kathy's collection of humanitarian aid started with no delay. This container filled up in a short period of three weeks as donations came in every day. About \$143,000.00 worth of blankets, sheets, clothes, toys, dishes, soaps, shampoo, hygiene items,

adult and children diapers were donated by caring Christians in Mississippi.

# TBILISI, THE REPUBLIC OF GEORGIA...5,000 PAIRS OF SHOES SHIPPED IN THE LORD'S NAME!

On January 4, 2019 in Lancaster, OH we loaded a container of new shoes for the orphaned, elderly and vulnerable in Tbilisi! The container arrived in Port on March 3 and was cleared for immediate distribution by the Georgian Customs on March 7! <u>FOUR DAYS</u> is all that the Republic of Georgia took to clear this container!! Contrast this with a container of shoes shipped into Ukraine in September and Ukraine's Customs still refuses to clear it!!

"The duty-free customs clearance was done today and the container will arrive tomorrow in the morning at the final destination site. The paperwork and logistics were perfect and I appreciate your immediate support a lot!

I cannot describe what a great inspiration I have in the work with kids' Christian club "Smart Fox." When I hear from the parents that their children are eager as to when there will be time to come for the class, it makes my heart smile.

The kids love each part of our class: **English** (we put efforts more in speaking skills), **Bible** (they like to listen to the Bible stories and then do practical tasks at home. For instance: the topic is care and how Jesus took care of hungry and sick people. A special task was assigned to show care to other people and after they did it, they tell us how it was) and the last part of the class but not less favorite – **Crafts** (here they show their ideas and creativity and just enjoy the process).

### IVAN'S REPORT ...

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters.

We always thank God for all of you and for your prayers on our behalf, for your help and love to God and your brethren in Ukraine.

A lot of people have heard about our Savior Jesus Christ this month. We give out Bibles together with relief items and talk to people about salvation, about Church, and explain to them what has to be done to be saved. Problem is that many people believe that going to church on holidays and blessing of the water and other things will help them and protect them from all evil. Unfortunately, such a deceptive doctrine comes from Orthodox priests, who are always unhappy with us and Lord's Church.

A few days ago, a woman came and said that she had heard about a Church that helped everybody and gave out Bibles. Her name was Miroslava and she came to ask for help. She was a mother of seven and A CONTAINER OF NEW SHOES FOR GEORGIAN ORPHANS

had hard time providing for all them. She had three daughters and four sons from 5 to 14 years old. Miroslava said she believed in God and attended church since she was little. She quoted the Lord's Prayer and Psalm 91 to us. We helped her and explained that the Bible teaches us to live by faith in God, that we have to change a lot of things in our lives, if we believe and trust God, and that her children had to be raised in the right way, for which she was responsible to God. Then she admitted that she gave birth to all her kids to survive as she did not have a job and had nothing to live on. With children she could live off the government, so she went for it.

As we help, we hear different stories from people and at times those stories sound incredible.

With humanitarian aid, we are able to support families that lost their husbands in the war and preach God to them inviting them to Church.

Thank God, church of Christ is known practically all over the region. We counted all the aid given to children's homes, different institutions and individuals, and we came up with the figure of 570 people that we helped last year. BIG THANKS to you, brethren, for your work and help.

We hope and trust that the seed of the Word of God that has been planted will soon bring forth fruit.

We continue worshipping on Sundays and teaching Bible classes on Wednesdays. We also have individual studies and meetings.

Our Sunday worship starts at 11:00 a.m. and is over at 1:00 p.m. Attendance is 30-45 people, and even more at times.

Sveta teaches the Bible to children. 6-12 kids come to her class. A lot of people are sick, both children and adults, especially now once spring has come.

We teach our Wednesday Bible class from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Attendance is 12-17.

On Friday, we have a prayer session praying for all needs and growth of the Church.

On Saturday, Anya and other students attend Bible classes that Gif teaches from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

In addition to these classes, Emmanuel has classes from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m., where he teaches medicine to African students and tells them about church of Christ. Five students come to our Sunday worship services.

Lord willing, we will have one more grandchild soon. Masha and Ruslan need prayers. Masha is three months pregnant. Please, pray for her.

We love you very much and thank you for everything.
