#### IVAN SKOLEBA'S NEWS FOR FEBRUARY...

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters in the Lord. As we pray, we always thank God for the joint ministry that we have together with you and for the joy that we share. Your prayers and support of the congregation here encourage us to give glory to God and to preach the Holy Gospel to others.

At this point we pray and ask the Lord to help us complete construction of the church building so that the congregation can move to the new building where we will work hard to give glory to God. First of all, having our own meeting place will allow us to set up different activities with people, children's Bible classes, have meetings with adults, conduct worship services and officially invite people to church, give out invitation flyers with our address while with this rented meeting place we are not allowed to officially invite people to this address or else we would be kicked out. The owner has warned Andrew and me several times not to advertise Church because he does not want priests to be upset with him and the priests are present in the Regional Rada when decisions are made for the Region and the city. All that can have a bad toll on his business. There are other things that I cannot write that make us feel ill and even bound hand and foot by warnings. That is why we pray and ask the Lord to help us move to our new meeting place where we will have more freedom. This constant fight and search for solutions requires much strength and plants disappointment in the hearts of our people.

In spite of all these problems we continue studying the Gospel and we always thank God for the warm and bright meeting place we have now.

Our Sunday worship assembly begins at 11:00 a.m. and is over at 1:00 p.m. We have tea and fellowship afterwards. After that Svitlana and I go to Zelena and teach Bible to a group of people that want to study the Word of God from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. Once a month, people from the village come to worship with us. On Wednesday we study the Bible and fellowship from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. On Friday, we have a joint prayer for our needs and give thanks to the Lord for His blessings.

We continue helping the needy and invite people to Church to study the Gospel. All members help one another while each one is trying to serve the Church with their talents and abilities. Svitlana teaches children's Bible class. We continue helping Freah. She is enrolled in an institute now and reads the Bible. We hope that the Lord will work things out so that she'll repent and want to be baptized. We pray to God asking Him to fill our new meeting place full of adults and children. We do all we can for that.

## COMPASSION IN SERVICE!

A container was shipped into Liberia late last year. It would furnish a clinic in Liberia that is managed by the Church there. It was loaded in Searcy, AR. Here is a report...

#### WORLD BIBLE INSTITUTE IN IVANO-FARNKIVSK!

Greetings, dear brother John. Sorry for a tardy reply. Men have met many times to discuss and advise concerning the Bible School. We have come to the conclusion that we do need a Bible school attached to the Church. First, it gives a good opportunity to stay in the Word of God with those who really want to study which helps them mature in spirit faster. Secondly, the education is free. We will have it as a part-time school this year. Students will have three days of classes and then study at home on their own. Third, Ruslan will be in charge of the School since neither me nor Volodya have the time to do direct the School. The American Directors have agreed to Rulsan being the Director if Volodya and I direct him in the doctrine. Four, we already have part-time students. They are Bogdan, Galyna, Petro and Tetiana from Zelena. Besides, Olexy and Mykola from this congregation who were baptized last year. As of today, we have 6 students and this number might grow. We will resume classes on February 17 and will teach: The Plan of Redemption and Genesis. Americans will come in March to teach the Life of Christ and Ethics.
